We are absolutely delighted to be able to tell you that Ofsted recently carried out a “No-Notice” inspection of the Oakwood Nursery provision in the Children’s Centre at Oakwood Primary Academy and have found that the Nursery, which transferred to Aurora Academies Trust last September, provides an “Outstanding” education for its children, achieving this highest judgement grade in all 3 areas of provision

The report states that *“The quality of the educational programmes is exceptional. Children’s progress in all areas of their development is excellent, given their abilities and starting points. Practitioners are highly skilled and have a very secure knowledge of how to support children’s learning”*

It further praises the Manager of the Nursery, Ms Sam Attwater and her team of staff ... *“Leadership and management are exceptionally strong and practices are inspirational. 


We are very proud of Ms Attwater and her team and it is clear that Oakwood Nursery is in very capable hands
